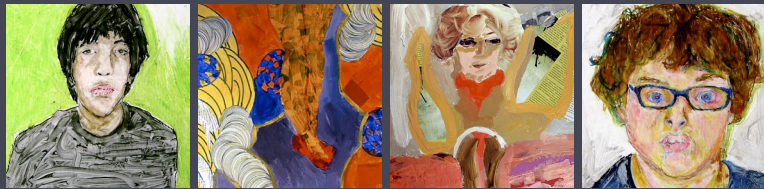


ABOUT

The JMF Art Studio Class provides a balance of technical instruction and creative expression. Students will experiment with a variety of materials, and have the opportunity to explore ideas and concepts in depth.

Lessons will be a combination of observation and imagination. All classes are taught by professional New York City artists. Anyone wishing to develop a portfolio for a specialized high school, summer program, or college admissions can apply for individual assistance with our Student Opportunities and Support (SOS) program.

Students will explore various drawing, painting, and sculpture techniques, as well as learning about contemporary and historical artworks. Students will be encouraged to develop critical thinking and creative problem-solving skills while mastering visual art techniques. All students welcome; no experience necessary.
